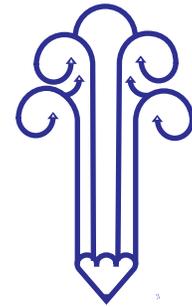
“BYWAY OF WRITING”

This year's theme is “Byway of Writing.” A byway, a little traveled side road, is an apt metaphor for the path we often take when writing. 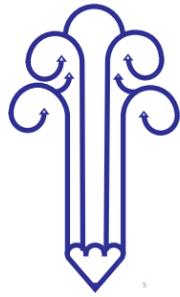

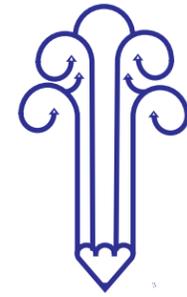
